



CLEAN AND WAX  
BLADES

IF THE MAIN ROTOR  
ON YOUR BABY GOES  
SNAP, CRACKLE AND  
POP, ON THE COASTDOWN,  
DON'T SWEAT IT.

The blades lose centrifugal force around 100 RPM, and the sound you hear is the slight movement of the blades back into the grips, amplified by the blades.

Those blades do need attention, tho, especially in humid salt-laden air.

STOP CORROSION BY WIPING  
THE BLADES WITH DRY-  
CLEANING SOLVENT, P-D-680,  
TYPE I, OR ALIPHATIC NAPHTHA,  
IT-N-95, TYPE II. FOLLOW UP  
WITH A MILD SOAP DETERGENT  
WASH.

PUT ON  
AN EVEN COAT  
OF WAX, MIL-W-18723,  
BUT DON'T POLISH IT...  
NO MUSCLE NEEDED.
